## **PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:**

May brought warmer weather and mosquitos. With the increase of these critters, we are asking families to send insect repellent to use during recess. Please label the repellent container with your child's name and remind your child that all application needs to be completed outdoors. Discussing safe and proper use with your child is an important. Due to the high cost of these products, we do encourage children not to share. We do have some spray that we can offer to students when they are going outside for a scheduled class lesson. If you do not want us to offer spray to your children, please contact your child's teacher.

Graduation convocation will be held on May 25 at 7:00pm. All families and community members are invited to join us in the gymnasium for this celebration. The banquet will be held at Radway hall and all invited guests are encouraged to arrive by 4:45 so they have ample time to find their seats before the banquet begins at 5:00. On behalf of the staff and students of TCS, we congratulate all of our students on their graduation and we wish them all the best on their future endeavors.

Final exams are approaching quickly. Students are reminded to stay focused, review their course material on a regular basis, get plenty of rest, and eat a well-nourished breakfast and lunch on the day of exams. Students are welcome to bring in water and a light snack into the examination room if they wish. Snacks may be required if a student is going to be writing for an extended period of time. Please watch the webpage and posting for your child's exam schedule.

Swimming activities are going to start soon. This year, the Thorhild Pool will be offering a Swim at School program instead of formalized lessons. The Red Cross Swim at School is a participation-based swimming and water safety training program designed specifically for schools that allows entire classes to participate at different levels of ability. The skills and knowledge in this program have been selected to prepare students to participate safely in aquatics activities. By focusing on fitness and developing life skills, students are exposed to a safe water environment when they are encouraged to participate and increase their swimming endurance. While students are not evaluated, the Water Safety Instructor can track students' abilities. Since all swimming lessons are being offered at no cost to Thorhild County residents, families are encouraged to register their children in the formalized Red Cross swimming program at the pool. We are looking forward to the swimming season.

TCS is pleased to announce that Mr. Zachary Rosychuk will be joining our teaching team as a replacement for Mr. Price. Mr. Rosychuk has a major in Social Studies and experience in teaching at the junior high and high school level. Mr. Rosychuk is an avid sports participant and is looking forward to being active with afterschool activities. Other staffing arrangements are being planned and as more changes are made, we will deliver this notice out to families.

As we prepare for next year, some of the areas we are exploring include eliminating semester for grade 9, one class for each grade, and offering shop semester one and cosmetology during semester two. Since all of these plans are in the infant stages of being developed, changes may happen. It is administration's goal to have the timetable finalized by the middle of June. Next year's grade 10 – 12 students will be selecting their courses during the last week in May.

Good luck to all of our farming families. We hope the weather is cooperative and you are able to get your crops planted on schedule. To our volunteer fire fighters, we thank you for continuing to keep our community safe.
