Principal's Report - February 28, 2022

- 1. Aspen View Public Schools COVID Restrictions Lifted
 - On Saturday, Premier Kenney announced that most of the remaining restrictions related to COVID-19 will be lifted as of Tuesday, March 1, 2022. This includes masking requirements in schools and on school buses as well (cohorting is no longer required). All meetings, regardless of when they are being held, can now be held in person. There are no restrictions on crowd capacity in facilities such as gyms and community halls.
- 2. "COVID-Keeper" Main Entrance as Sole Point of Entry
 - o Main School Doors will remain locked until further notice
 - All school visitors must call TCS first to arrange meetings with teachers or school administration (i.e. school visitors cannot simply arrive at the school and expect meetings to be scheduled).
 - o School visitors must report to the General Office and sign in
 - School visitors must have prior authorization from school administration before accessing any part of Thorhild Central School
- 3. TCS PowerSchool Automated Phone Calls, Texts, E-mail for Student Lates and Absences are sent out:
 - Elementary 9:15 a.m. (absences and lates)
 - End of the day attendance 6:00 p.m. for each period (absences and lates)
 - Junior & Senior High (Block 1, Periods 1-2) 9:03 a.m. (absences only)
 - Junior & Senior (Block 7) 1:00 p.m. (lates and absences)
 - All parents and guardians have the option of choosing to receive alerts in PowerSchool for their own children
- 4. Alberta Education Assurance Surveys
 - Alberta Education has begun mailing survey information to parents and guardians of TCS Grade 4, 7, & 10 students. Parents/guardians will receive survey packages from Alberta Education. Included in each package will be a letter containing a Random Access Code for accessing and completing the survey online.
