Our casino is being pushed back to 2024 due to COVID causing a backlog of organizations that need to complete casinos for funding. The budget will be tight for the next 2 years. The items that will stay on the initiative list are the funding of student awards, the Library Book Program and Bussing for annual field trips. All other items will require a request and a vote.
